

Make your own Stickman

Follow the simple instructions below with the help of a grown up, to make your own Stickman just like the prop from the show!

Why not also make a cave and some puppets and get your family to help you perform The Gruffalo's Child Live on Stage in your living room.

Things you will need:

- 2 sticks
(Try to find a Y shaped stick for the body and a slightly shorter straight stick for the arms.)
- 2 googly eyes
- Glue
- Some yarn in any colour that you like
- Scissors

Instructions:

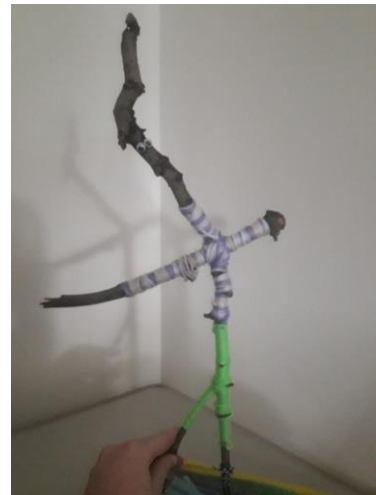
Step 1 — Make the body

- Place your straight stick across the Y shaped stick to make the arms.
- Use some yarn to tie the sticks in place.



Step 2 — Making some clothes

- You can leave your stickman as it is or, if you want to, you can make some clothes for him like we have.
- To make the clothes, wrap the two sticks with any coloured yarn you like.



Step 3 — Add the eyes

- Ask a grown up to help glue the googly eyes to your stick man.



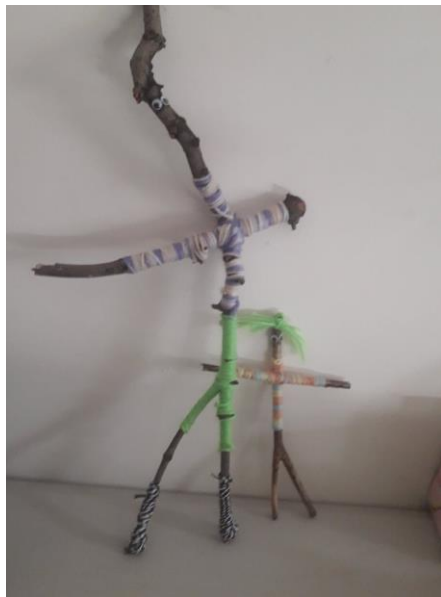
Step 4 — Add some hair

- You can leave your stickman as it is or, if you want to, you can add some hair like we have.
- To make the hair, wrap some yarn around your hand and then tie a knot around the middle.
- Where the yarn is looped at the opposite end to the knot, as a grown up to help cut the yarn.
- Tie or glue the hair bundle to your stickman's head.



You can make stick people in any size or colours that you like.
